Did you know??

The K8TIH repeater has many functions that are both useful and informative. Below is brief summary of some them feature that you may use as a WCARC club member.

Telephone Functions:

As a reminder you must follow all FCC regulations regarding autopatch functions. Which includes that you must be physically located in the local call area to make an autopatch. Also you must clearly identify yourself at the conclusion of an autopatch.

Manual Autopatch:

- Type * then telephone number (without unkeying and do not include a 7 in your number). The repeater will read back the number typed in before it makes the call.
- Type # to hang up the phone. *Please remember to ID*
- Type * alone to redial last number
- Type *1 to extend the autopatch timer
- Type *3 to mute the "radio" side of the autopatch.

Speed dial:

If you have a local Bowling Green telephone number, WCARC members may have up to 3 speed dial numbers programmed into the repeater. To dial your number you need only enter a three digit code.

Signal Test:

Did you ever wonder how you sound into the repeater? Well since the club has installed a digital voice recorder (DVR) you can perform a talkback test.

1. Type 44 * and then unkey.

- **3.** Key up and then say something up to 30 seconds in length, then unkey.
- **4.** The repeater will beep twice and then echo back what you said.
- 5. Remember to identify after using this feature.

Solar Activity Still High

excerpted from ARRL Propagation Bulletins

The sun is still providing us with good propagation conditions. As of June 22, the sunspot numbers for this week rose over 43 points because of the appearance of a new group of sunspots. The average solar flux was up 32 points. The sunspot number on Fathers' Day was 289, the highest since April 1, when it was 320. Around the end of March there was a huge increase in sunspots, which will probably move the smoothed value for the peak of Cycle 23 to a later date than earlier assumed. Over the past two weeks we have witnessed another large run up in activity, although not quite as sharp but perhaps a little more sustained than the increase at the end of March.

We have just passed the summer solstice, and from now until the end of the year the days get shorter. Several months from now we will be back to fall conditions, with better 12 and 10 meter openings, especially in the higher latitudes.
