A Tale of Two Antennas

Heavy winds and ice in January conspired to split the repeater transmitting antenna that was mounted atop the Administration Building on the BGSU campus thus rendering it inoperable. After much discussion and research into the matter, the technical committee has purchased and installed a new antenna. It is a Cushcraft ringo ranger AR270B. According to the spec sheet, this antenna "has a low angle of radiation and it is only 7.7 feet(2.35m) high. The AR270B is computer optimized with two 5/8 wavelength colinear elements on 2 meters and four 5/8 wavelengths on 70 cm. It is broadbanded for minimum SWR on both bands." A prime consideration in purchasing this antenna is that it is all-metal construction. Each of the last two antennas that have been destroyed by natural causes were of fiberglass construction. The Technical Committee feels that the sturdier construction should pay off in longer life.
