After reciting the Pledge of Allegiance, the minutes of the last meeting were approved as printed. There was no Treasurer's report.

Old Business:

- President Bob, WB8NQW, reported that the issue of WCARC space in the Fairgrounds Administration Building was on the agenda of the Fair Board for the next meeting, December 17, 2009. He assumes that a decision will be made.
- Having no volunteers or nominations,
 Bob polled this year's officers and they
 agreed to serve for the year 2010, so
 there is no need to hold an election at
 the Banquet meeting.
- The choices of venue for the banquet and the costs were reviewed, including Ben's Table in Bowling Green, Maggie's in Perrysburg, Nasladeh in Bowling Green and Couzin's in Grand Rapids. Motion was made by Steve, K8BBK, and seconded by Jim, W8JU, to hold the banquet at Couzin's-motion passed.
- Jim reported that the KC8UMN repeater was just about ready to go on the air. He will be looking into the details.

• The issue of the second repeater (the former 145.19 wide area machine) was discussed. Jim reported that he did not believe that it was worth the trouble to resuscitate because of the age of the equipment. Discussion was closed.

New Business:

• Bob raised the issue of fund raising ideas for discussion. Several comments regarding the possibility of a 50/50 drawing, etc., were batted around. It was pointed out that the current situation where funding depends on member dues is a break even proposition, with expenses such as telephone line, post office box, etc., just being met. It was suggested that if a major repair was needed, contributions could be solicited. Meeting adjourned at 7:55 pm.
